Redding Reloading Equipment Creates First Ever Piloted Debur and Chamfer Too

Cortland, NY......New for 2016, Redding Reloading Equipment has introduced a first of its kind, Piloted Case Chamfer and Debur tool. This unique take on a proven tool adds tremendous benefit, which guarantees a concentric chamfer for accurate bullet entry for seating and pull on firing. Redding has added a central pilot shaft with a small pin to center within the primer pocket's flash hole. The distance from the pilot to the cutter assists in true alignment of the cutter within the center of the case mouth opening.

Minimizing variations always improves accuracy and, this tool assures both concentric location of the cuter and a uniform angle of cut around the circumference of the case mouth. This uniformity leads to an improved level of pressure consistency during the seating process, maintaining the bullet centrally within the case mouth. This becomes even more important with flat based bullets which rely on the chamfer for their initial start in the seating process.

Included are the chamfering tool, a pilot shaft which will work with both small and large flash holes and an Allen wrench for pilot shaft depth adjustment allowing the tool to work with nearly all cases of .22 to .475 caliber. Case mouth chamfering is a long held and appreciated handloading practice. Now Redding has added a new level of precision
