## Universal Decapping Die Instructions

Thank you for choosing Redding Reloading Equipment. Your new Universal Decapping Die allows you to deprime and clean your cases before sizing. The small decapping die (Part #69100) will handle 22 and larger caliber cases up to 2-½" long. The large decapping die (Part #69200) will handle 7mm and larger caliber cases up to 3" long. An optional 17 & 20 caliber decapping rod (Part #69250) is available for small decapping die. The (Part #69250) rod is also designed to be used with BR and PPC cases having small .060" flash holes. To exchange decapping rods, simply remove the small clip from the decapping rod at the top of the die.

- Install the correct shellholder in your reloading press and raise the ram to its uppermost position.
- Screw the decapping die into your reloading press until it makes light contact with shellholder and tighten the lock ring against the top of your reloading press.
- Tighten the set screw on the lock ring and you are ready to start decapping.
